Investing in first-rate local organizations to build their capacity to feed kids where they live, learn and play.



Working with lawmakers to pass policies that make it easier for kids to get the healthy meals they need, every day.

- National lawmakers turn to us for counsel on ending childhood hunger in this country.

- Advocates from across the nation attend our summits, webinars and trainings to learn how to feed kids.

LOCAL AND TARGETED

- We issue thousands of grants each year to schools and community groups to purchase equipment – like meal trucks, refrigerators and other equipment – so they can serve healthy food to kids in need.
- We fund the very best local organizations – like schools, food banks and community groups – working to end childhood hunger in all 50 states.
- Low-income families know where to find food for their kids because of our localized awareness campaigns.
- Local meal providers – like summer meals sites, afterschool meals programs, and schools – turn to us for guidance to help them launch or improve their programs so they can feed more kids.
